

Outer South Community Committee FACEBOOK highlights

Since 2nd June 2017 the Outer South Community Committee Facebook page has gained:

- 52 new page 'likes' (and currently has)
- 563 followers

This means that this is the **fourth** most popular Community Committee page—but we're working on this!

There are two things to note in general:

- 'reach' is the number of people the post was delivered to
- 'engagement' is the number of reactions, comments or shares

Engagement tends to be a better way of gauging if people are interested and have read the posts, because they wouldn't have interacted with it otherwise. For example, a post might reach 1,000 people but if they all scroll past and don't read it, the engagement is 0 and it hasn't been an effective way for the Community Committee to communicate.

Having said that, posts can be read without any further interaction!!

By far the most popular post since the 2nd June was the posting regarding the **Outer South Community Heroes Event** which:


- has been shared 28 times
- commented upon 50 times
- has 218 specific post clicks
- has reached a total of 4859 people

4,859 people had this post delivered to them. 218 people opened it to read it in more detail.




2nd Place
