

# Inner North East Community Committee FACEBOOK Highlights

## 1 July 2019 - 20 August 2019

Since 1 July 2019 the Inner North East Community Committee Facebook page has **736 page 'likes'** (and currently has) **806 followers**.

This means that this is the 6<sup>th</sup> most popular Community Committee page.

There are two things to note in general:

'reach' is the number of people the post was delivered to 'engagement' is the number of reactions, comments or shares

Engagement tends to be a better way of gauging if people are interested and have read the posts because they wouldn't have interacted with it otherwise. For example, a post might reach 1,000 people but if they all scroll past and don't read it, the engagement is 0 and it hasn't been an effective way for the Community Committee to communicate.

By far the most popular post since the 1 July was the posting regarding Leeds West Indian Carnival & Black Music Festival Road Closures. It has;


- received 259 post clicks
- shared 23 times
- reached a total of 2,088 people

The following are screenshots of the most popular three posts since the 1 July 2019. Alongside it are the figures for how many people were 'reached' and how many people 'engaged' with the post.

## 1st Place

#### **Carnival Street Closures**

**2,088** people had this post delivered to them and it had **259** post clicks, with **26** likes, comments and shares.



## 2<sup>nd</sup> Place

#### Youth crime and violence - views needed

**1,545** people had this post delivered, with **89** post clicks. There was also **9** post likes and **14** shares.



### 3rd Place

## **Meanwood Olympics 2019 post**

**596** people had this post delivered, with **13** post clicks. There was also **6** post likes and **4** shares.
