FACEBOOK highlights

29th October 2019 - 25th November 2019

Since the last Community Committee meeting, the Inner East Community Committee Facebook page has gained: 44 **new page 'likes'** and currently has **949 likes** and **1006 followers** (an increase of 50 since the last committee meeting).

There are two things to note in general:

- 'reach' is the number of people the post was delivered to
- 'engagement' is the number of reactions, comments or shares

Engagement tends to be a better way of gauging if people are interested and have read the posts because they wouldn't have interacted with it otherwise. For example, a post might reach 1,000 people but if they all scroll past and don't read it, the engagement is 0 and it hasn't been an effective way for the Community Committee to communicate. Posts can however be read without any further interaction.

The most popular post since 29th October was regarding the Preventing Youth Violence Grants announcement. The post:

- has been shared 20 times
- has reached a total of 2,674 people

The following are screenshots of the most popular posts since the 29th October. Alongside it are the figures for how many people the post reached and how many people engaged with the post.

1st Place - Preventing Youth Violence Grants

2,674 people had this post delivered to them and it had 248 post clicks, with 85 likes, comments and shares.





2nd Place – Leeds Assylum Seekers Support Network- Meet and Connect

1,196 people had this post delivered, with 61 post clicks. There were also 20 likes, comments and shares.
