FACEBOOK highlights

26th September 2019 - 26th November 2019

Since 26th September 2019 the Inner North West Community Committee Facebook page has gained: **22 new page 'likes'** (and currently has) **598 followers.**

There are two things to note in general:

- 'reach' is the number of people the post was delivered to
- 'engagement' is the number of reactions, comments or shares

Engagement tends to be a better way of gauging if people are interested and have read the posts because they wouldn't have interacted with it otherwise. For example, a post might reach 1,000 people but if they all scroll past and don't read it, the engagement is 0 and it hasn't been an effective way for the Community Committee to communicate. Posts can however be read without any further interaction.


By far the most popular post since the 26th September was the posting Fine Free Library. The post:

- has been shared 1 times
- has reached a total of 148 people

The following are screenshots of the most popular two posts since the 26th September. Alongside it are the figures for how many people were 'reached' and how many people 'engaged' with the post.

1st Place - Leeds City Council Fine free library

The post had 7 post clicks, with 6 likes, comments and shares.



2nd Place – Leeds Recycles

People reached were 178, with 9 post clicks. There were also 4 post likes.
